- All participants must attend a training and orientation meeting on Thursday June 4, 2026.
- An Application, Parade Entry Description and Participation Agreement (included with this packet) must be submitted.
- The 55th Annual Juneteenth Jubilee Parade will be shown live on TMJ4, please make sure you completely fill out the description of your parade entry in the packet.
- **EACH VEHICLE IN THE PARADE MUST BE REGISTERED AS A PARADE UNIT; NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- Faith-based, non-profit, community, and education organizations are eligible for monetary awards in the float, dance, and marching band competition. Please make sure you check off the category on the application. (\*\*Note: Large businesses and corporations will not be considered for monetary prizes)
- For the safety of parade goers, candy and/or novelty items must be distributed in a bag.
- **ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES OR THE USE OF ILLEGAL OR NON-PRESCRIBED DRUGS ARE NOT ALLOWED.**
- Participants are responsible for ensuring that every part of the float is secure.
- **Items prohibited on floats or trucks/cars include, fire, live animals, smoke machines, dry ice, firearms, and explosives.**
- The Juneteenth Parade Committee will be inspecting the floats the day of the parade to ensure safety requirements are met.
- Northcott Neighborhood House, the Juneteenth Planning Committee, and TMJ4 reserves all rights to record and reproduce video, audio, music, and digital images of the parade event for both publication and unrestricted distribution.
